West Oakland Environmental Indicators Project



WOEIP is a resident led, community-based environmental justice organization dedicated to achieving healthy homes, healthy jobs, and healthy neighborhoods for all who live, work, learn, and play in West Oakland, California. What is the Oakland Shoreline Leadership Academy?

A six month training and planning process focused on the Oakland Shoreline. Participants will be paid to learn about the shoreline, make their own plans for the shoreline, and communicate with the greater Oakland community about what they have learned.



Why?



Empower the Voices of Those Most Affected.

The Oakland Shoreline is inhabited by a majority of low income people of color, yet the decision makers for the shoreline tend to be wealthy, white, and not from the shoreline community. The Oakland Shoreline Leadership Academy is an attempt to put the power of planning into the hands of the people most affected.
