#### **Thematic Analysis**

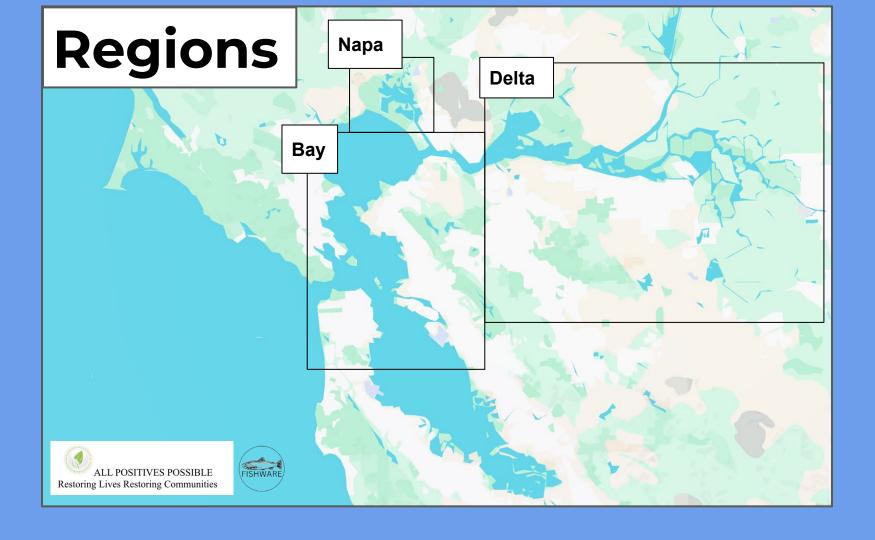
- Coded forms in Excel

  - Asked questions
  - Sorted answers by region

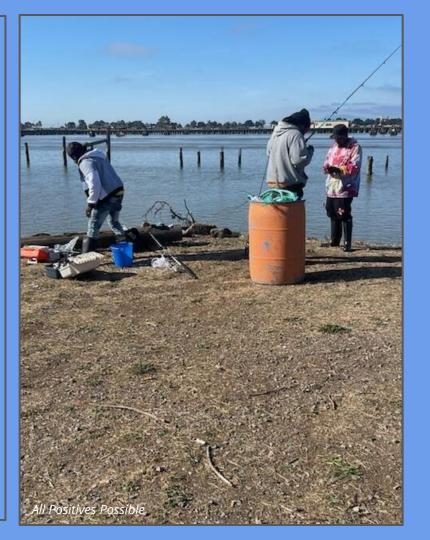


## **Key Points**

- Surveys

    - additional sites in responses
  - 87 total surveys
- Fishing
  - Most people fished across regions
- Catches
  - Striped bass captured across sites
  - Salinity influenced other catches
- Consumption
  - o 1 8x/mo
  - Variety of cooking methods

## **Bay Responses**

How often do you eat the fish you catch?

- "When I catch it, I eat it" (4-5x/mo)
- "My family eats the fish I catch" (~2x/mo)
- "Majority of times we eat our catch or give it away" (5x/mo)
- "Fish is my favorite food, eat it everyday...only like striped bass and sometimes salmon"
- "More than those fish advisory list, not real recommended in my opinion" (2x/mo)





## Quotes

How often do you eat the fish you catch?

#### Delta Respondents

- "I eat what we catch" (4x/mo)
- "Whenever I catch them, I don't buy from the market. I eat fish weekly." (8x/mo)
- "I and my family do eat it and share it with co-workers and friends too." (not specified)





## Quotes

How often do you eat the fish you catch?

#### Napa Respondents

- "All the time" (4x/mo)
- "When I catch it" (5x/mo)
- "I don't eat fish but I like catching and sharing." (4-8x/mo)
